Purpose of Prayer Walking or Driving

Prayer walking allows you the privilege of walking and praying among the rocks!

Prayer walks come in many different shapes, sizes and styles. Not everyone, or every church, will approach it the same.

That is okay!

The main purpose is to get out into your city, your territory, and physically pray among the people that you are trying to reach. Walk their neighborhoods, the places they do business and everywhere they work, go to school and play.

Your influence will be monumental as you break down walls in the spirit world and open up their hearts to receive Jesus Christ!

There is no real scriptural basis for prayer walking as it is done today. Yet there is nothing said against walking and praying! The early Church, the apostles, walked nearly everywhere they went, surely at times they prayed while they walked!

We also know that we do not have to be in a particular place, at a specific time, for God to hear or answer our prayers. "If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you." John 15:7. God is omnipresent, He is everywhere! He will answer according to His will and His timing. Yet we know He will honor our efforts. It may be that we are praying in a certain neighborhood, concentrating our efforts in one area, and never see anyone won to God from there. But visitors begin to show up at church that no one invited...God is honoring the efforts of His people!

Targeting an area for Revival

Prayer walking allows you to TARGET the city, pick out places, neighborhoods, etc., that you want to focus on, and then zero-in on the needs there.

Prayer examples: For instance, if you come upon a school, you can **pray for the teachers, students, and administrators that they will be protected from harm.** You can **pray for God to bring prayer into the schools. Pray that the minds of the children would not be corrupted with ideology that would take them down a wayward path.**

In a neighborhood, as you pass by each home, **ask God to open their hearts to hear the Word of God.** Pray that they will be **led to Truth**, that **their eyes would be open and their hearts tender to receive the Gospel.** Pray for **protection in each home, for the love of the parents to transfer to the children, that each child is loved, cared for and safe.**

Entreat the Lord to send someone, (maybe you!) to share the Good News with them.



Look at Abraham in the book of Genesis:

“Lift your eyes now and look from the place where you are – northward, southward, eastward, and westward; for all the land which you see I give to you and your descendants forever. And I will make your descendants as the dust of the earth; so that if a man could number the dust of the earth, then your descendants also could be numbered. Arise, walk in the land through its length and its width, for I give it to you.”

Genesis
13:14-17 NKJV.

Reclaiming Territory

We are taking back territory with the Authority given to us by Jesus Christ and the power of the Holy Ghost!

God wanted Abraham to possess his land, to truly make it his own. There were not any descendants as of yet, just Abraham and Sarah. It might have been difficult to see down the road but a promise is a promise, and when Abraham took control of his land, walked in its entirety, the Lord fulfilled that promise right then and there. It belonged to Abraham and those that would come after him, forever.

Taking Dominion

That is what prayer walking is all about. Taking dominion, authority and control away from the enemy and declaring the territory belongs to God and His people.

We walk, we pray, and we boldly proclaim that the Kingdom of God is here to stay and liberate those that live there.

Every little neighborhood, village and town can be brought back under the authority of Jesus Christ, leaving the enemy dumbfounded!

Barbara Lardinis, of Hannah's Cupboard Ministries, suggests.
spying out the land when beginning your prayer walks.

In Numbers 13, the Lord told Moses to,

“...Send men to spy out the land of Canaan,
which I am giving to the children of Israel.”

Moses obeyed, and before he sent the twelve away he gave them
this instruction.

“...See what the land is like: whether the people
who dwell in it are strong or weak, few or many; whether the land
they dwell in is good or bad; whether the cities they inhabit are
like camps or strongholds; whether the land is rich or poor; and
whether there are forests there or not. Be of good courage. And
bring some of the fruit of the land.”

Numbers 13:18-20 NKJV.

Assessing the Spiritual Conditions

Prayer walking is the same concept:

Assessing the land! Look with spiritual eyes, not with the natural as did ten of those twelve sent out.

They came back and told Moses that it was true, it did flow with milk and honey and had fruit like they had never laid eyes on before! But...they were looking in the natural and were afraid of the people.

“Nevertheless the people who dwell in the land are strong; the cities are fortified and very large...we are not able to go up...for they are stronger than we.”

Numbers 13:28-32 NKJV

Thankfully, Joshua and Caleb didn't see it that way.

“Then Caleb quieted the people before Moses, and said, ‘Let us go up at once and take possession, for we are well able to overcome it.’”

God wants us to go in faith, believing that He is with us, giving us the strength and authority to take back what rightfully belongs to the Kingdom of God. There will be hindrances and difficulties to overcome, but that is what prayer is for. Prayer walking breaks down the strongholds the devil has on a territory and allows the liberty of the Spirit of God to come back into its rightful dwelling place.

Have faith that God has given you the city and go forward,
believing and claiming His Word.

This is not "Necessarily" a Contact Time -

It is not the primary purpose of prayer walking to interact, but be open to opportunities to do so and bless people that may grow out of your experience.

If anyone does ask what you are doing, be prepared to respond with something to this effect: "We are praying God's blessing on this neighborhood. Is there any special way we can pray for you?"

Then do not write down their prayer request and plan to pray later...pray right there.

If it is appropriate, take hold of their hand and tell them you will believe together for God to intervene in their situation and His will to be done.

Be bold in the Holy Ghost, yet gentle in your approach.

Truly they will be touched by your prayer and your faith! Even if they do not outwardly show it, the Lord will touch them while you pray in faith believing. They will never forget it!

Preparation

Before You Go...

We must be prayed up and ready to meet the spiritual forces that we will face when we head out.

1) You MUST be prepared.

Repent and consecrate yourself, forgive or ask forgiveness from God and others. be spiritually clean.

It is VERY important before going out on a prayer walk to be holy. In other words, turn from all wickedness, and be full of the Spirit of God and prayer. Put on the whole Armor of God. You are marching right into Satan's territory. We are not just talking about outward appearance, although that is crucial.

2) Be Spiritually Professional

You should look nice when you go out on the street. Business casual, hair fixed nice, make an attempt to look well kept. You are representing your church and your God. You are on business for the King.

3) Go by two's or most three.

4) Obtain your Prayer Route from the Pastor

5) How to Pray on a Prayer Walk

Take a Notebook - when the Spirit gives you something specific write it down.

Some prayer walkers like to take a notebook along with them. In it they may have specific scriptures, prayers, and ideas they like to pray while they are out. It also helps remind them not to forget anything and how to pray particular spiritual warfare prayers.

Praying scripture is so effective when you prayer walk!

It tears down strongholds and paves the way for the Spirit to do a work.

“Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.”
Ephesians 6:10-18.

And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.”

Matthew 16:18-19.

2. Staying your area

After your territory has been divided among your group, try to stay in that area that you have been assigned. What you are doing is of utmost importance. Breaking down walls and inviting the Spirit of God to have full reign is powerful and needs to be accomplished for revival to come. Do not take it lightly but rejoice that you have a part in seeing souls come into the Kingdom.

Remember:

- You can be on the scene without making a scene. Do not draw attention to yourself.
- You may take turns praying out loud in a conversational voice.
- When you pray, you will want to bind spirits that are not of God and loose spirits that ARE from the Lord. For example, you can bind the spirit of fear, and loose the peace of God. (A chart is available at the end of this lesson for easy reference.)
- Do not cast spirits out of strongholds; simply bind them.
- Pray for anything that comes to mind as you are walking.
- God will give you direction if you are sensitive to the Spirit as you walk and pray.
- As you pass a neighborhood, or home, ask for the Lord to open their understanding and put conviction in their hearts. Pray for their eyes to be opened and for the entire family to get a hunger for God.
- Pray the scriptures! Some scriptures you can use while praying and walking in your territories. Acts 26:18, Romans 15:14, 2 Corinthians 10:5, 2 Thessalonians, 3:1 and Jeremiah 29:11.
- Pray that there would be miracles, sign, and wonders with an outpouring of the Holy Ghost. (Mark 16:17-18)
- Some actual examples of prayers to pray:
- “Lord God, I ask in the name of Jesus that You would draw the people here into a personal relationship with You.” (John 6:44)
- “I plead in the name of Jesus that You would grant the people here a hunger and a thirst for You and Your Word.” (Psalm 42:1-2)
- “Jesus, I pray that You would meet the emotional needs of the people in this place. Heal their emotional wounds.” (James 1:17; Psalm 147:3)
- “Lord, grant freedom from pressures that keep the people of this neighborhood on run from You.” (2 Timothy 1:7)
- “Wean the family in this home from the spirit of busyness and that the devil will let loose his grip on them. Let them see their need of You!” (Psalm 46:10)
- “Renew in this city a desire and hunger for the things of God.” (Revelation 21:6)

Conclusion:

One of the missionaries in the country of Latvia felt led to pray around a certain apartment building every single day of his prayer walk time. He couldn't understand the need he felt to intercede there but followed the leading of the Spirit regardless.

Several weeks into evangelism, this Missionary had his computer open one night working on a video/picture presentation to take back to the States. One of the new converts sees a picture and asks,

“Where did you get that picture of my apartment?” He was astonished that the apartment he had been led by the Lord to travail over, day after day, turned out to be the home of his very first convert that he witnessed to on the street!

Prayer walking changes things!

God will work THROUGH you to bring about His will! Hungry people who long for a change in their life, who are searching for Truth, or maybe not even knowing what they are searching for...God will lead them and He will lead YOU...just be sensitive. People are watching you.

The praying Church in the world is the kingdom come.

The prayer-walking Church in the world is the kingdom coming.

You do not have to leave your city to find hungry people.

They are right where you live, on your block, your street, in your neighborhood. In your family, school, workplace, wherever you are daily, you can count on there being people who do not know God!

These are just examples to help get you started on your prayer walk journey.

You will think of others that you can write down and save in your journal. Note taking will become natural while you are out walking.

You will think of specific things to pray, or scriptures will come to mind in particular areas. Be sure and jot them down for reference later. If you get stuck or seem to run out of things to pray, you can always pray the Scripture.

There are many Psalms that are appropriate and would apply to the effort that is going forth.

Pray in Jesus' Name and watch walls come down and souls come into the Kingdom!

“Look among the nations, and see; wonder and be astounded. For I am doing a work in your days that you would not believe if told.”

Habbakuk 1:5 ESV.

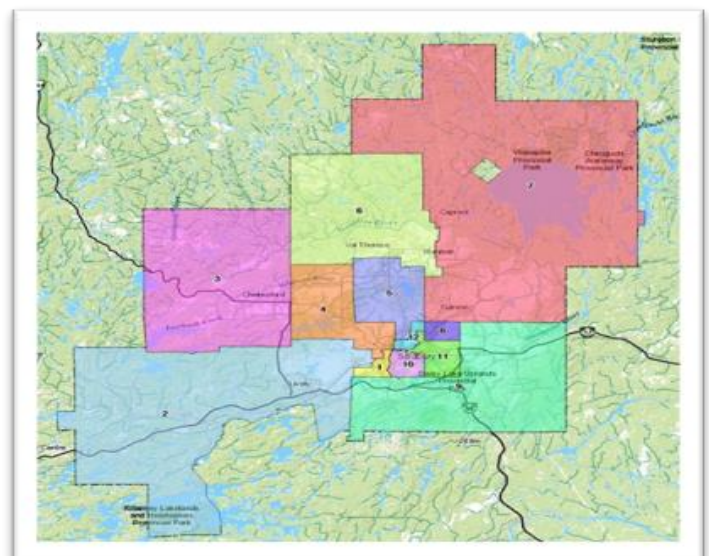
